### Character Match-Up: Instructions

#### Character Match-up

Print out a picture of Farmer Brown, Cow, Hen and Duck. Enlarge them and post them on the board. Say or sign a statement from the list below. Let the students decide if the phrase belongs with Farmer Brown, Cow, Hen or Duck and write it under the appropriate character. (Note that some statements may apply to more than one character.)

An alternate version of this activity requires more reading: write the phrases on strips ("\_\_\_\_\_ demanded milk and eggs," for example) and have the students take turns reading each phrase and deciding which character it belongs to. You may also choose to create a worksheet with all the phrases, and have the students fill in the blanks independently.
