**Day 3: Princess Presto Day**

**[INTERVIEWER]** We're going to play a game with letter sounds. I'm going to say a sound, and you tell me what letter makes that sound, ok?

**[INTERVIEWER]** Say: What letter makes the sound /C/?

**[CONTINUE THROUGH THE WHOLE LIST BELOW]**

**[CODING: Write a '1' next to the sound if they say the correct letter name. Write a '0' if the wrong letter is said.]**

(Make the sound /c/ as in CANDLE)	___ C	<b>Total:</b> _____
(Make the sound /r/ as in RABBIT)	___ R	
(Make the sound /t/ as in TOP)	___ T	
(Make the sound /o/ as in OCTOPUS)	___ O	
(Make the sound /A/ as in APPLE)	___ A	

**PART TWO: ENCODING**

**[INTERVIEWER]** Say: Ok, now I'm going to ask you to spell a word. How do you spell CARROT?

**[CODING: Mark a "1" for each correct letter said in any order, and add a "1" if the whole word is spelled correctly AND in the right order.]**
